1. The required qualifications to be a Mentor are:
 - a. Colorado attorney, with an active license, in good standing, and engaged in the practice of law; or retired Colorado attorney, who retired from the practice in good standing.
 - b. No suspensions or disbarments from the practice of law from any jurisdiction, nor surrender of license to practice law for purpose of disposing of pending disciplinary proceeding in any jurisdiction.
 - c. No sanction by a governing authority in the five years preceding application as a Mentor.
 - d. No formal disciplinary complaint pending before Attorney Regulation pursuant to C.R.C.P. 251.12, or current participation in a diversion program pursuant to C.R.C.P. 251.13. An attorney is not disqualified from serving as a Mentor if an investigation was conducted or if there was previous successful completion of participation in a diversion program, and no formal complaint was filed.

- 2) I have read the foregoing requirements and limitations;
- 3) I agree to and understand the terms and as such qualify to be a CAMP Coffee List Mentor; and
